

FRANCESCO BAGNASCO, violino



Francesco Bagnasco began violin studies at the age of 11 with Riccardo Capanni at the "Niccolò Paganini" Conservatory of Music in Genova. He follows his studies with Valerio Giannarelli, and, in 2014, he degrees with full marks. He took part in many violin and chamber music masterclasses, with Michael Frischenslager, Cristiano Rossi, Bin Huang, Adrian Pinzaru, Klaidi Sahatci, Marco Fiorini.

Francesco played in Quartetto Januensis, which gave concerts all around Italy (Genova, Milano, Torino, Trento, Bolzano, Lucca) and took part in chamber music masterclasses with Nuovo Quartetto

Italiano, Quartetto di Cremona, Quartetto Prometeo and Delian Quartet.

He worked with different orchestras, such as Orchestra Nazionale dei Conservatori, Orchestra Sinfonica di Savona, Orchestra Haydn.

As a member of the contemporary music 'Noos Ensemble', founded and directed by Massimo Lauricella, he played in Genoa, Livorno and France (Nice, Lion).

Since autumn 2014, Francesco plays Niccolò Paganini's music for violin and guitar in duo with Fabio De Lorenzo.

He is currently studying at "Giuseppe Verdi" Conservatory of Music in Turin, with Piergiorgio Rosso, and at Accademia di Musica di Pinerolo with Adrian Pinzaru
